Introduction and objectives of work

The Board of Directors of Granules India Limited (hereinafter abbreviated as "Granules") have engaged us to carry out an independent verification of its Greenhouse Gas Inventory assertions ("the GHG Inventory") i.e. Scope 1, Scope 2 and applicable categories of Scope 3 emissions data as defined by the ISO 14064: Part 1 Standard and covering the Company's emissions over the period **01st April 2025 to 31st March 2026**, which forms part of the Company's response to the Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP).

Intended User

The assurance statement is made solely for "Granules India Limited" as per the governing contractual terms and conditions of the assurance engagement contract between "Granules" and "Bureau Veritas". To the extent that the law permits, we owe no responsibility and do not accept any liability to any party other than "Granules" for the work we have performed for this assurance report, or our conclusions stated in the paragraph below.

Scope of Work

We have performed the **Reasonable Assurance engagement for Scope-1 & Scope-2 emissions and Limited Assurance for Scope-3 emissions** of applicable categories in accordance with International Standard on Assurance Engagements (ISAE) 3410 and in line with the requirements of Bureau Veritas's standard procedures and guidelines for external Assurance of Sustainability Reports, based on current best practice in independent assurance. The verification applies a $\pm 5\%$ uncertainty towards errors and omissions.

The Scope of work agreed upon with Granules includes verifications of its GHG emissions (Scope 1, Scope 2 and selected categories of Scope 3) as listed below:

Scope 1 emissions arising from

- Consumption of diesel and Petrol (in DG Sets, Boilers and intermediate transportation),
- Coal,
- Furnace oil Consumption,
- Usage (topping up) of different refrigerant gases

Scope 2 emissions arising from

- Use of purchased electricity from Grid

Scope 3 emissions from categories (GHG Protocol) of

- Category 1 – Purchased Goods & Services
- Category 2 - Capital Goods
- Category 3 - Fuel and Energy Related Activities
- Category 4 – Upstream transport & Distribution of raw materials
- Category 5 – Waste generated in operations
- Category 6 – Business travel
- Category 7 – Employee Commuting
- Category 8 - Upstream Leased Assets
- Category 9 – Downstream transport & distribution
- Category 10 - Processing Sold Products
- Category 12 – End – of – life treatment of Solid Products

The Categories 11,13,14 & 15 are not applicable to the organization and the reasons for the same has been provided in the GHG Inventory report.

As part of its independent **Reasonable Assurance engagement for Scope-1 & Scope-2 emissions and Limited Assurance for Scope-3 emissions** of applicable categories, we assessed the appropriateness and robustness of underlying reporting systems and processes used to collect, analyse and review the information reported. In this process, we undertook the following activities:

The assessment was carried out through physical site visits at Hyderabad's Corporate Office, API Unit I, Finished Dosage Unit, R&D Units 1 & 3, and API Units IV and V. Bureau Veritas interviewed personnel of Granules's including HR & Admin, EHS, Engineering & Maintenance, SCM, Finance & Accounts, Quality Assurance & Quality Control, Legal & Compliance, Information Technology and other relevant departments.

Verification Methodology

The verification was conducted by Bureau Veritas for the following activities:

- Desktop Review of Granule's emissions provided in spreadsheets
- Management interaction on data management systems and review of emission factors and assumptions at HO & Sites
- On site assessment for the data monitoring and reporting at HO and site.

Nothing has come to our attention to indicate that the Scope-3 emission related disclosures for applicable categories in GHG inventory report are inaccurate or that the information included therein is not fairly stated.
